Schedule: 6th Graders meet on **Sunday mornings at 9:45AM**. All confirmation students are invited and expected to regularly worship as a part of the CtK community. A comprehensive schedule for the year will be handed out on **September 23 at the 6th grade orientation**.

6th Grade Focus: The 6th grade year will engage a variety of learning styles with the hope of providing an interactive and experiential environment. The content for the year will focus on:

- Discovering the Lutheran identity
- Lutheran Sacraments
- Worship
