## What to expect on Sunday Mornings

### *In-person indoor worship resumes on Sunday, June 6*

*"If one member suffers, all suffer together with it; if one member is honored, all rejoice together with it. Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it."*

1. If you are not feeling well, or are uncomfortable gathering with us in person, please stay home and join us online.  
*We will continue to live-stream all of our services.*
2. We ask all to wear facemasks while in the CtK building.  
*As a faith community, we are committed to doing everything possible to protect the most vulnerable among us especially those who have not yet been vaccinated, those who are unable to be vaccinated (children under 12), and those who have compromised immune systems.*
3. Upon entrance to the CtK building we ask everyone to sign-in in case there is ever a need to contact trace.  
*The church building will be open by 9 am every Sunday and sign-in information will only be kept for three weeks.*
4. For the comfort of everyone in the sanctuary, please maintain physical distance in the pews.  
*Ushers will help fill the pews from the center of the pews to the ends.*
5. Singing will be provided by worship leaders.  
*No congregational singing at this time. Group speaking is allowed.*
6. If fully vaccinated, worship leaders may remove their mask when speaking or singing.
7. For now, food and drink will not be provided in the church building on Sunday mornings.  
*Coffee Hour will resume initially outdoors after worship beginning Sunday, June 20.*
8. Offering plates will not be passed during worship.  
*You may leave your offering in the baskets at the center aisle of each pew at any point during worship or when you are leaving. You may also hand your offering to any staff person or usher at any point.*
9. Nursery will be made available every Sunday.
